

Catanzaro – Squillace: inaugurated the catechesis of the Apostolic Movement

"Every man, son of God, has got the right to get the salvation announcement and we, as Church, have got the duty to bear such incarnated announcement". These are the words issued by the Archbishop of Catanzaro – Squillace, Mons. Antonio Ciliberti, during the solemn Eucharistic Concelebration, in the parish church of S. Janni in Catanzaro, for the inauguration of the organic, systematic and permanent catechesis of the Apostolic Movement, at the presence of Mons. Anthony Chirayath, Bishop of Sagar of the Siro – Malabaresis (India), of numerous priests, nuns and laypeople.

To present a filial greeting to Mons. Archbishop was Mons. Costantino Di Bruno, the central ecclesiastical assistant of the Apostolic Movement, who, while reading the chosen theme, thanked the directive and the members of the Apostolic Movement: the inspirer and founder, Maria Marino, who for near 30 years with determination and firmness has been reminding the Word of the Lord, arousing the faith awakening and leading the souls to God; the president Cettina Marraffa, the central secretary Augusta Corea, all the responsible people and collaborators.

"Despite the daily fatigues and the unavoidable sadness – said the Bishop in the course of his homely – the believer knows he can rely upon God's power". In its service the Church is the container of the goodness of the absolute values, since it received the mandate by Christ Himself: "Go into the world and announce my Gospel: those who will believe will be saved". A mission which the Apostolic Movement, born in Catanzaro on November 3rd 1979, feels to be called to.

"I wish all of you, who live the spirituality of the Apostolic Movement – concluded Mons. Ciliberti – to be the witnesses of the joy you bear in your hearts".
