



Cosenza-Bisignano: the catechesis of the Apostolic Movement

«Evangelisation is communication»: to affirm this was the Cosenza-Bisignano Archbishop, Monsignor Salvatore Nunnari, who in the course of the solemn Eucharistic Co-celebration inaugurated the Apostolic Movement's organic, systematic, and permanent catecheses.

The evangelisation is the strongest challenge that the Church is called to face. A mission that the Apostolic Movement, founded in Catanzaro 3 November 1979, through the inspirer and founder Maria Marino, brings forth with zeal and perseverance, reminding the Word of the Lord to whomever has forgotten it.

Monsignor Nunnari, in thanking all those who live the spirituality of the Apostolic Movement, commented, in the light of the Word, the theme that will accompany the catecheses in the course of the pastoral year 2006-2007: «The joy of the faith and the education of the young generations».

According to the Bishop the faith must be transmitted with simplicity, «by living and not imposing it», in order to let it become adult and mature.

Christ's rule of life must be assumed by the Christian with the witness of life fully lived according to the Gospel, which becomes «light of the world and salt of the earth»; since the holiness of the Church is manifested in the holiness of every one of her members, just as the II Vatican Council mentions: «Lord Jesus divine teacher and model of every perfection, to every one of his disciples of any condition, preached the holiness of life, of which He himself is author and perfect observer» (L.G. 40).
