Patti: the catecheses of the Apostolic Movement

With the solemn Eucharistic co celebration presided by the Bishop Monsignor Ignazio, Zambito, were inaugurated for the tenth year in the diocese of Patti the organic, systematic and permanent catecheses of the Apostolic Movement.

«This is a thanksgiving day to the Lord – the Bishop said -, of confirmation of the goodness of the Holy Spirit among us; of commitment in the journey of evangelisation». Words that confirm the ecclesial life of the Apostolic Movement, willed by God, through the inspirer and founder Maria Marino in order to remind the world the Word of the Lord, inviting man to conversion.

Monsignor Zambito has already written in the 2006-2007 pastoral plan, affirming that: «It is urgent that, together with our people, we move close to the Bible again. We cannot loose time, because the world is awaiting Hope..., He who possess the fullness of life and the power of recapitulating all in God».

«I thank the Lord – that is how the Bishop concluded – because I see people that commit themselves, organise and get together to announce the Gospel; to let Jesus be known. I wish you to be live witnesses of the coming true of the Word of God among us».

The catecheses that will have as a theme: «The joy of the faith and the education of the young generations», read in the light of the Gospel of the day of the Lord, will be held in the Oliveri «S. Joseph» Parish, every Thursday at 5.30 pm..
