

Porto-Santa Rufina: the Apostolic Movement's catecheses

The Porto Santa Rufina bishop, Monsignor Gino Reali, inaugurated at Fregene the organic systematic and permanent catecheses of the Apostolic Movement on the theme: «The joy of the faith and the education of the young generations». The solemn Eucharistic co-celebration, that took place in the solemnity of Christ, King of the Universe; saw the presence of priests and lay believers that live the spirituality and the charisma of the Apostolic Movement. «Monsignor Reali said – It seems to me to be a gift of the providence that the inauguration occurs in this day, for the fact that we celebrate Lord Jesus, King of the Universe; and we conclude a year's journey that, day after day made us relive the mystery of the presence of the Son of God; know once more his word and adhere to it; receive the gifts of his grace; run through a path of conversion and faithfulness; meet our brothers in the faith and feel a part of a Church that the Lord keeps on edifying and towards which our belonging and our responsibility is deepened».

The Bishop remarked that the commitment of transmitting the joyous faith to the new generations must be the preoccupation of the Church, that takes to heart both the evangelization of those who still do not know the Gospel of Jesus the Lord and the solid education of all her sons. «The Bishop remarked – The faith that we received as a gift. A faith that we must try to live day by day. And then, we rediscover that we cannot limit ourselves to saying some words. We must be able to become witnesses». Monsignor Gino Reali, inviting the present people to be a sign of the love of God among men, has thus concluded his homily wishing the adherents of the Apostolic Movement a good pastoral journey.
