

Crotone-Santa Severina: the Apostolic Movement's catecheses

The Kroton-Santa Severina diocesan Administrator Monsignor Francesco Grandina, presided in the church of the Immaculate, in Kroton, the Eucharistic co-celebration for the beginning of the organic, systematic and permanent catecheses of the Apostolic Movement.

Father Gesualdo De Luca, the Apostolic Movement's regional ecclesiastic Assistant, in greeting the diocesan Administrator, the priests present and the people of God, illustrated the theme of this year's training: «The joy of the faith and the education of the young generations»; which aims at showing the joyous face of the Church that feels the duty of transmitting the faith to the young generations. He addressed a greeting to the inspirer and founder Maria Marino, for the faithful fulfilment of the mission entrusted her by the Virgin Mary, the Redemption Mother; to the president Cettina Marraffa, for the new forms of announcement of the Gospel that confer it freshness and beauty; to the central ecclesiastical assistant, Monsignor Costantino Di Bruno; to the central secretary Augusta Corea; to the priests, and to all the believers that live the charisma of the Apostolic Movement: «Reminding the world the Word of the Lord», «You are the workers – Monsignor Grandini said – that heard the Lord's invitation, that today sends you to our society, to our diocese, to all the Italian dioceses where you are scattered and work; to announce his Word and be witnesses of the hope of eternal life». Monsignor Grandini exhorted everybody to carry out with perseverance this charisma of announcement and memory of the Gospel.
