

## Rossano-Cariati: inaugurated the Apostolic Movement's catecheses

For the first time of his new Episcopal ministry in the Archdiocese of Rossano-Cariati, the Archbishop Santo Marciànò has inaugurated, with a solemn Eucharistic Co-celebration in the "Christ the King" parish of Cariati Marina, the organic, systematic, and permanent catecheses of the Apostolic Movement, on the theme: «The joy of the faith and the education of the young generations», read in the light of the Gospel of the «day of the Lord».

The Bishop, in addressing the believers present, greeted with joy the priest of the Apostolic Movement. «I have had the chance – Monsignor Marciànò said – of appreciating the priests that live the spirituality of the Apostolic Movement for their education and their commitment». An endeavour of evangelization which is the strongest challenge that the Church is called to face. A mission that the Apostolic Movement, founded at Catanzaro 3 November 1979, through the inspirer and founder Maria Marino; keeps on doing with zeal and perseverance, reminding the Word of the Lord to whom has forgotten it.

To the Bishop «the faith must be transmitted with simplicity, living and not imposing it; recuperating the sense of life inside a love logic; standing at the foot of the cross with Mary, in order to contemplate the crucifix, symbol of God's ineffable love». «Today – that is how Monsignor Marciànò expressed himself – there is crisis of faith because there is crisis of truth and the natural outlet of the catechesis is the witness, which requires a serious education in the faith».

The catecheses and the spirituality meeting will be held in the «Christ the King» parish at Cariati Marina every second and fourth Sunday of the month, while in the «S. Joseph Worker» parish at Pietrapaola Marina every first Sunday of the month.
